Instructions for Abstract(s)

1. Each abstract **MUST** be concise and preferably have a target length of about 300 words, and at most, submission should be limited to a single page. The intent is to provide sufficient information so that the selection jury can ascertain whether the abstract should be accepted or not, and if accepted, to allocate it to a specific session.
2. The format should be either in WORD or as a PDF file, using a pitch of 11.
3. The Title **MUST** be at the top of the page and be concise.
4. The main author and coauthors and their affiliation (including e-mail addresses) **MUST** be listed with the title in the abstract. Reviews of abstracts by the selection jury will not be "blind".
5. Each abstract submitted should answer the questions - **WHY, HOW, and WHAT is the conclusion(s)**. In other words, the abstract should have a brief introduction and description of the problem or goal, but focus on what was learned or achieved. Since **you will be judged on the value of the paper / presentation to the design community**, the focus must be on the conclusions. If a work is still in progress, please indicate that fact.
6. Include **Keywords** at the bottom of the abstract submission.
